**PUBLIC NOTICE – NORTHERN DRAINAGE STORMWATER PIPE**

Narromine Shire Council would like to advise the community that construction works have commenced to improve the stormwater pipeline system. These works are essential to enhance drainage and mitigate potential flooding during heavy rain. Council asks residents to take note of any traffic management measures in place and exercise caution when travelling through the area. The project is expected to be delivered over a six-month period with completion by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025, weather permitting. There will be various intermittent road closures during this time with detours and traffic management in place throughout different stages of the project. ### **PUBLIC NOTICE - DANDALOO STREET UPGRADE**

Narromine Shire Council would like to advise the community that upgrade works will commence on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2025 to improve vehicle and pedestrian access to the approaches of the Dandaloo Street Railway Crossing. There will be closures during this time and traffic management in place throughout different stages of this project. The partial closure of Dandaloo Street may impact parking for some local businesses. Access to shopfronts will not be affected. Plans and dates may change due to weather conditions or operational requirements. ### **PUBLIC NOTICE - SPEED LIMIT REVIEW**

A speed limit review is underway on Tullamore Road/McGrane Way encompassing the area between the railway line and a point approximately 250m south of the Backwater Cowal culvert. A review has been triggered by three crashes on the bridge in the past 18 months. NSW Transport is assessing the speed limit from the current 80 km/h zone (south of the railway line) to the southern end of the bridge. If approved, the existing 80 km/h zone would be extended by approximately 325m. Given the accident history, high number of heavy vehicles, road curvature and narrow road width, the review will determine the safest speed limit for this section.

### **BUSH FIRE PRONE LAND MAP**

The NSW Rural Fire Service (RFS) Commissioner certified a new Bush Fire Prone Land Map for Narromine Shire Local Government Area on 7 March 2025.

The updated mapping data is now available on the Bush Fire Prone Land tool on the NSW RFS website. As part of the latest update, Vegetation Category 3 grasslands, which cover approximately 80% of NSW, have been included. Bush Fire Prone Land Mapping plays a crucial role in development control, ensuring that potential bush fire risks are properly assessed. Any new development, alterations, or additions requiring a development application must comply with the NSW RFS Planning for Bush Fire Protection (PBP) requirements.
